17TH INTERNATIONAL INTER-SCHOOL REGATTA 2025

The 17th International Inter-School Regatta (IISR), hosted by Karachi Boat Club, was an intense and exhilarating competition, bringing together over 38 schools and 483 athletes from Pakistan, Russia, and Indonesia. Spanning from January 27th to February 2nd, the regatta featured two days of indoor racing followed by three days of outdoor events, culminating in a thrilling finals day on Sunday. The event not only highlighted fierce competition but also provided local athletes with the invaluable experience of racing against international crews.

The indoor races, held on January 28th and 29th, saw athletes competing in individual and relay events. Over the course of these two days, 16 indoor

THAILAND ROWING & INDOOR ROWING REGATTA 2024

Karachi Boat Club took part in the 2024 Thailand Rowing, Kayak and SUP race from 14th-15th December at Phutthamonthon Park, Nakorn Pathom, Thailand. The KBC team comprised of Head Coach Asghar Ali, Saif Malik, Muhammad Asad, Zuraïn Tahir, Abyaan Omer, Kazima Aejaaz and Huriya Faisal. Many clubs participated from different countries around the world such as Sri Lanka, India, UAE, and China along with others. The competition was intense with sculling events of 1x (single scull) and 2x (double scull) as well as indoor events, testing the athlete's hard work and determination.

Our training began 2 months prior to the regatta, 6 days a week and was intense, we trained both on water as well as the erg. The beautiful course in Bangkok was a short sprint of 500m and so were the indoor races. The categories the KBC team participated in were U16, U19 and the Open category. The heats and erg time trials took place on 14th December and the semifinals and finals on 15th December. Not only was this event a showcase of talent and dedication in Pakistan but also a wonderful opportunity to bond with people of different ethnicities and cultures and share the beauty of the sport of rowing with them.

The regatta concluded with an award ceremony recognizing winners from each race and category. The KBC team brought 9 gold medals back to Karachi and a total of 23 medals.

records were broken across various age categories, demonstrating the ever-improving standard of competition. One of the most remarkable performances came in the U25 men's 2000m race, where Nikita Kudriashov from Saratov Regional school of Olympic Reserve set a blistering new record of 6:08, breaking the previous mark by several seconds. With record-breaking performances from Russian, Indonesian, and Pakistani athletes alike, the competition was a testament to the growing talent in school rowing. Following a well-deserved rest day on January 30th, the outdoor races began on January 31st and ran until February 2nd. Events ranged from sculls and pairs to eights, with each race testing the endurance, skill, and determination of the athletes. One of the most unforgettable moments of the regatta came in the U18 girls' eights race, which featured only two crews—KGS and CAS—but delivered one of the most dramatic finishes of the entire event. The race ended in a photo finish, with the KGS crew making a thrilling final surge to catch CAS in the last strokes. It was a breathtaking display of resilience and competitive spirit that left spectators on the edge of their seats. The competition for the overall trophies was equally intense.

CAS emerged victorious winning the Ikram Cup with a total of 179 points. KGS, coming in second finishing with 168 points, and Nixor College placed third with a total of 105 points. The Kiran Foundation and Ida Rieu College for the Deaf and Blind put up outstanding performances, adding to the competitive atmosphere. Beyond the medals and records, the regatta was an incredible learning experience. Racing against international athletes pushed local crews to their limits, and watching the Russian team train after the first day of outdoor racing was particularly inspiring. Their technique, power, and discipline provided valuable insights into the level of preparation required to compete at an elite level.

The 17th IISR was a true testament to the rising standard of rowing in Pakistan. With international participation, record-breaking performances, and thrilling races, the event showcased not just athletic excellence but also the sportsmanship and determination that define this sport. As the final strokes were pulled, every athlete left the regatta with unforgettable memories and lessons to carry forward.

WORLD ROWING INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP 2025
