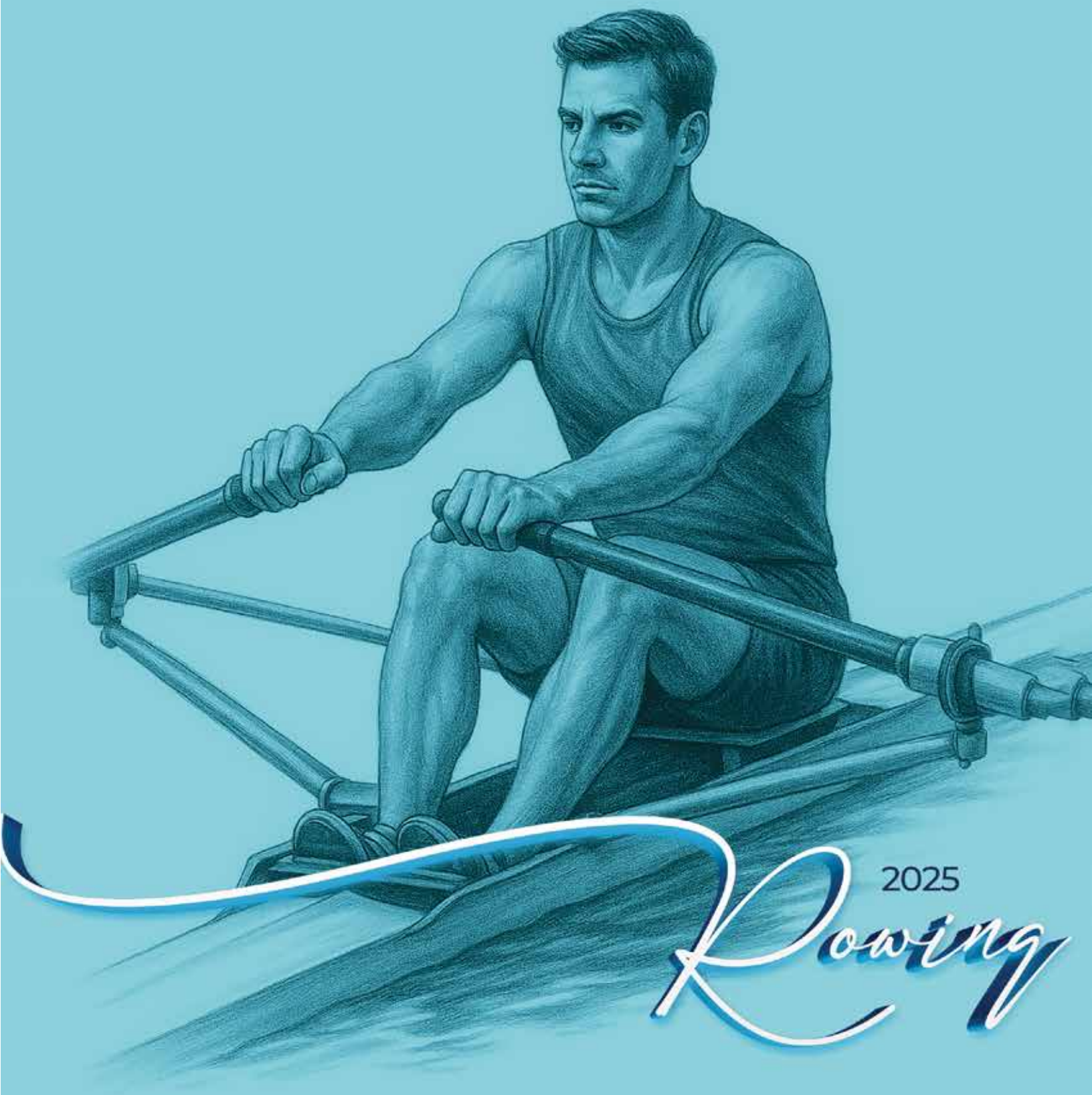

Rowing Highlights of 2025

Rowing at KBC is about more than racing. A big part of the year focused on learning, building skills, and opening the sport to more people.

International

KBC rowers proudly represented Pakistan at major international regattas this year. Starting from the Concept 2 World Indoor Challenge to the Grand Moscow Regatta, the team raced among athletes from over many countries and earned podium finishes with silver and bronze, supported by the Pakistan Embassy in Moscow and Consul General Andrey Fedorov. The Dutch International Youth Regatta in Amsterdam saw KBC rowers compete under Captain of Boats Mr. Arif Ikram and Head Coach Asghar Ali, winning gold with recognition from the Ambassador of Pakistan and Mayor of Amstelveen. Members also joined the Vladivostok Coastal Regatta and Concept 2 Virtual Challenge, marking another strong year of teamwork and international friendship for Karachi Boat Club.

Club & National Regattas

It's been a full year on home waters with regattas that brought the KBC community together.

The most prominent, ISR'25 brought together more than 480 rowers from schools within Karachi and International Olympic Reserve teams from Russia and Indonesia.

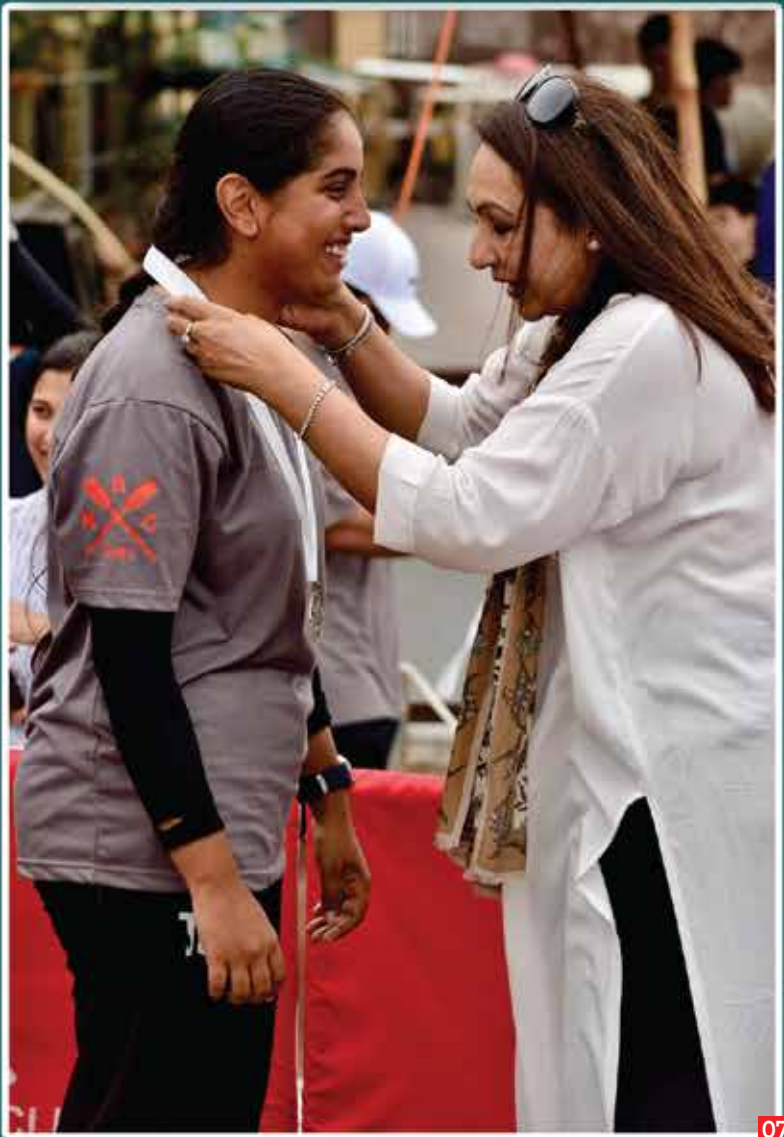
The Spring and Masters Regattas combined competition with camaraderie under Mr. Arif Ikram and Coach Asghar Ali. Green Stroke Regatta on Independence Day united rowers from schools across Karachi, attended by Mr. Nadeem Kazmi, KBC President, alongside prominent club members. The Summer Regatta featured Ida Rieu College for Blind and Deaf students, rowing for the first time alongside the novices from summer camp on water, while the Alumni Rivalry Cup closed the season with friendly races and laughter. Each event showed how rowing continues to strengthen both skill and community at KBC.



Developmental

KBC focused this year on building skills and making rowing more accessible. Coaching and umpiring workshops led by Captain of Boats Mr. Arif Ikram, talented rowing member Wajeeha Khan, and others trained new coaches and volunteers. The Masters Learn-to-Row Program introduced adults to the sport, with many later racing in the Masters Regatta. The club added new equipment to the boat house with new set of oars and two boats enhancing state-of-the-art fleet. The School Outreach Program expanded training for Kiran Foundation and Ida Rieu College students, with a new pontoon giving safe water access. These efforts reflect KBC's commitment to learning, inclusion, and the steady growth of rowing in the community.



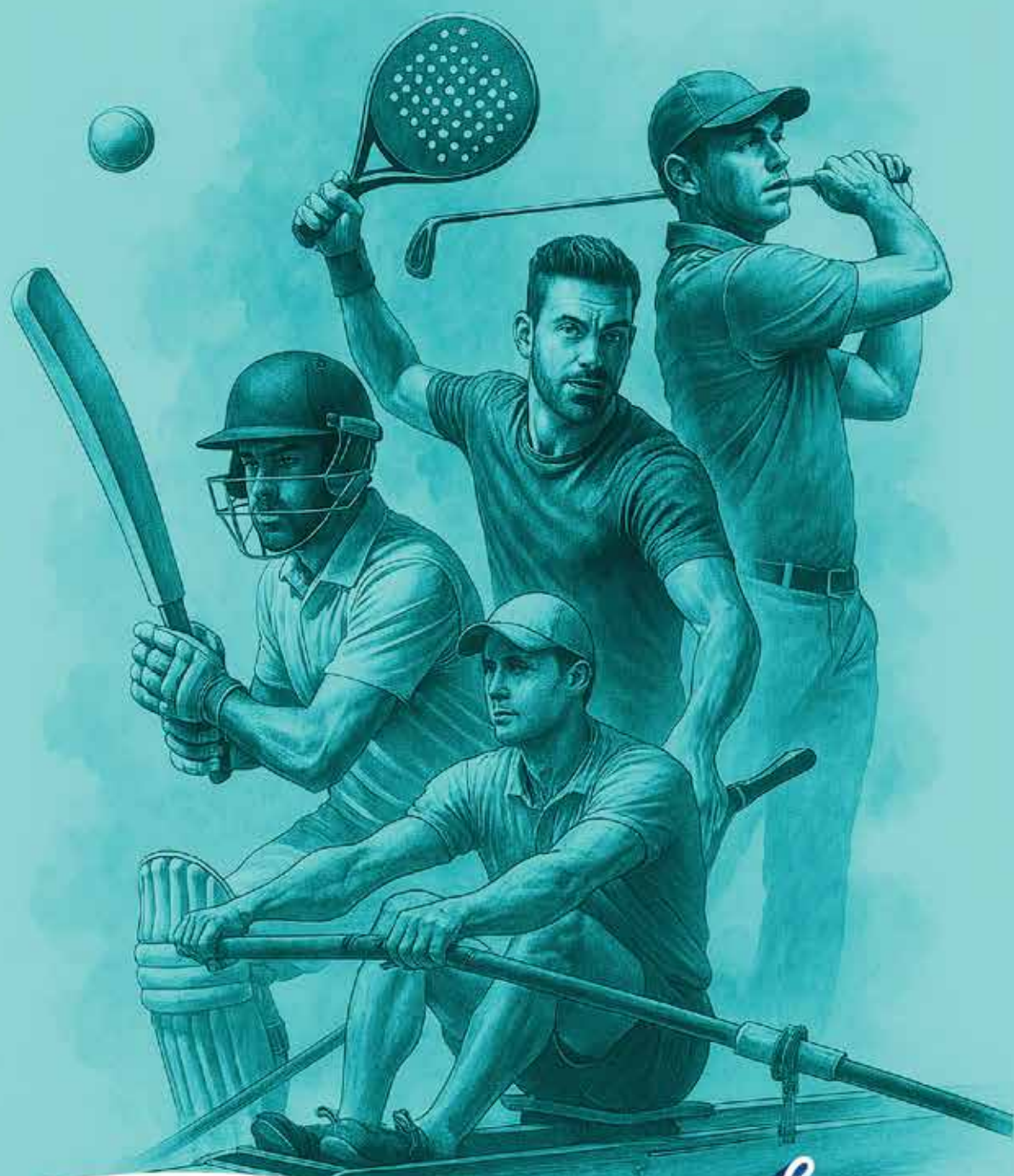

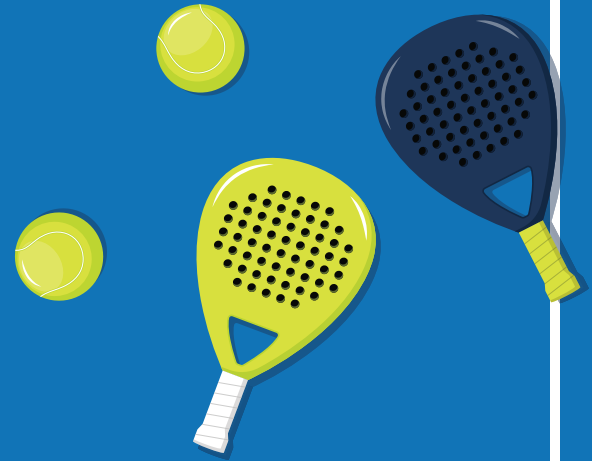

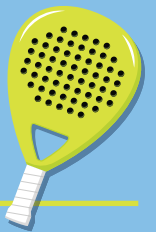


The Scull & Bastion Padel League

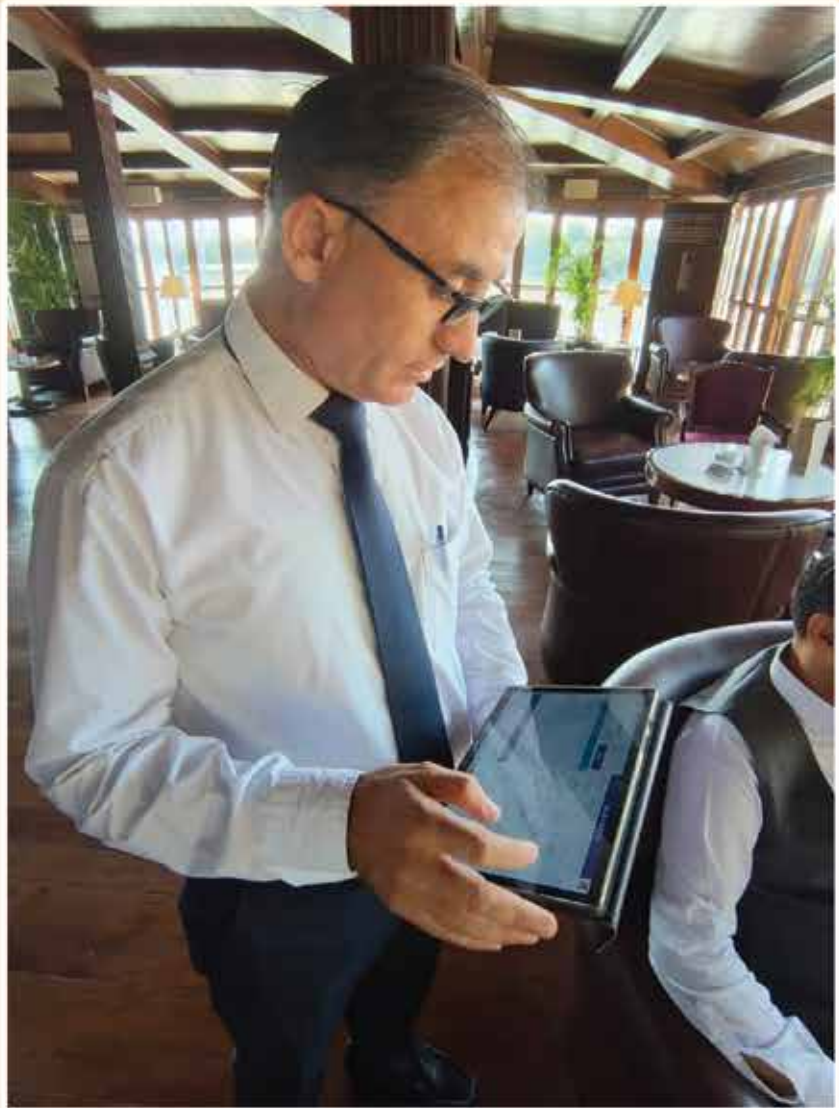

In Memory of Mr. Polad M. Polad

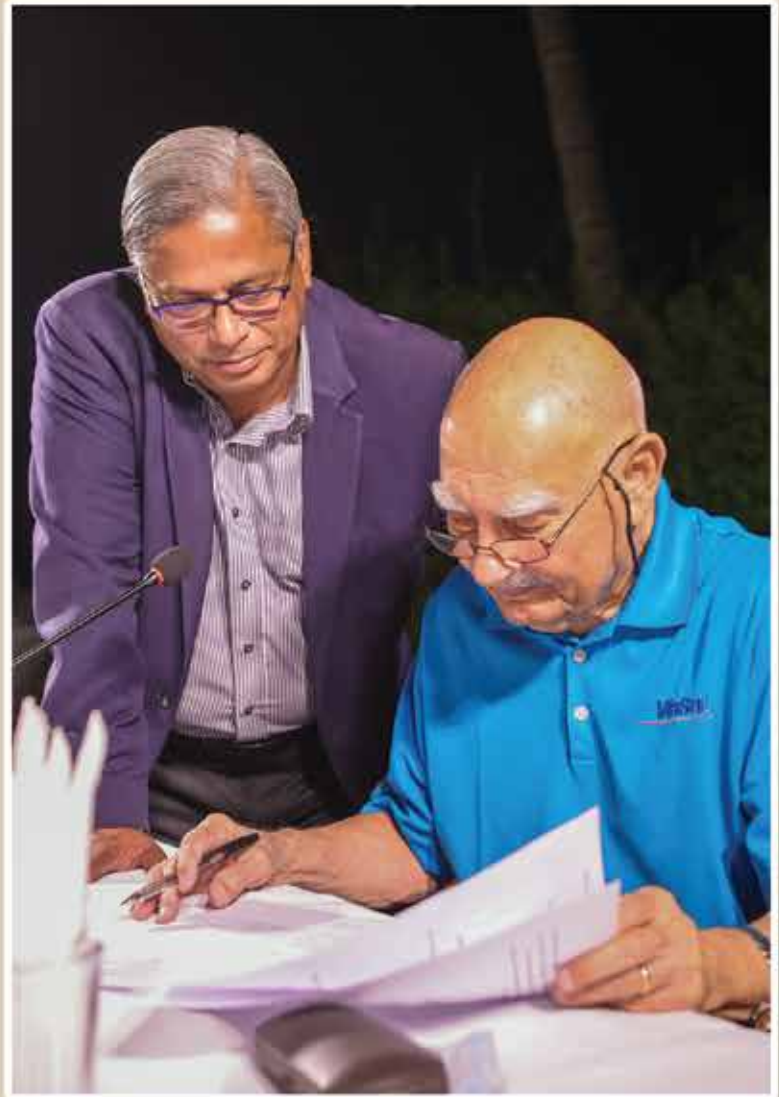

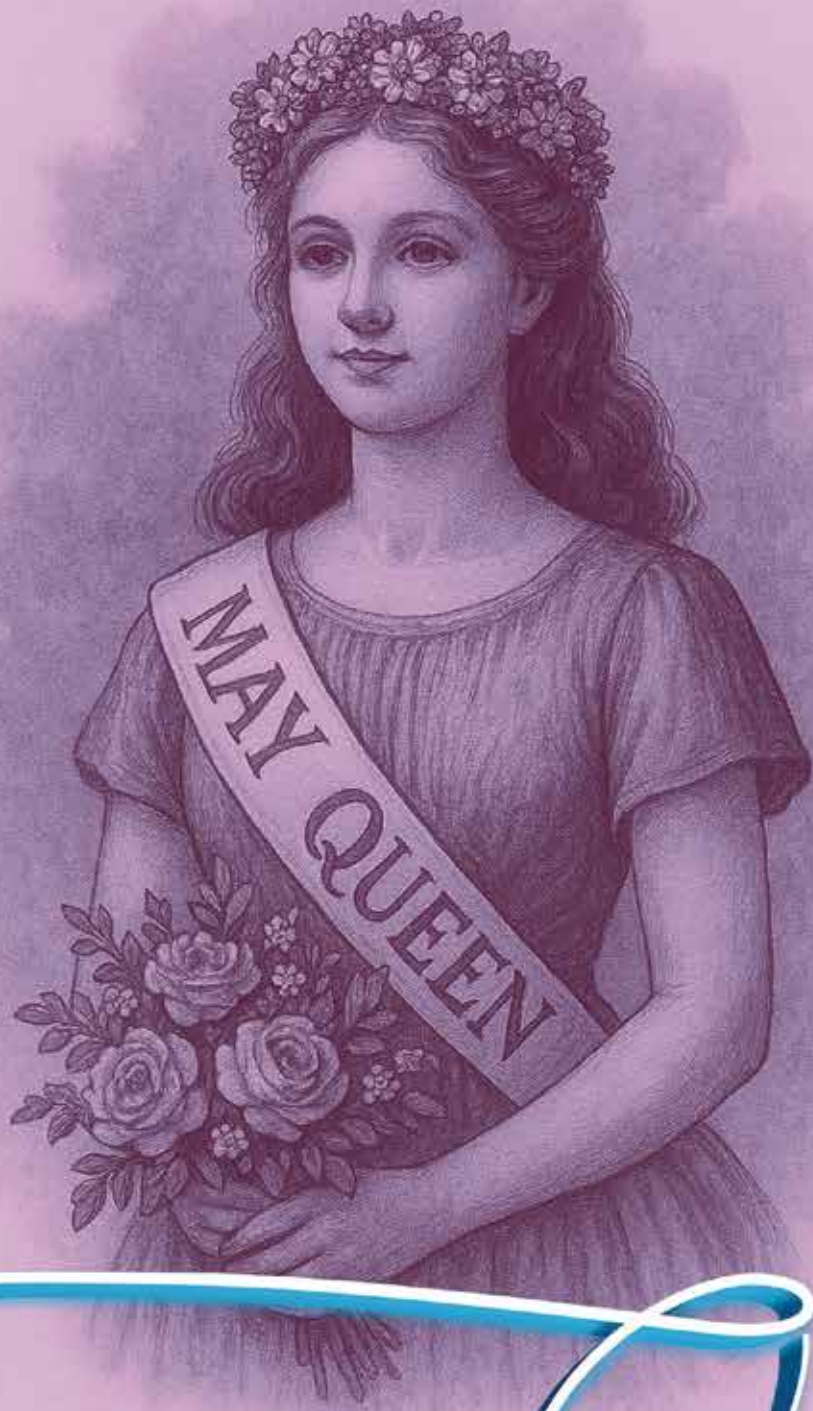
